

### **OVERVIEW**

The 1LC can butt fuse  $\frac{1}{2}$ " CTS to 1" IPS (16mm to 34mm) service sizes. The 1LC offers a more conventional style of operation than the Mini-Mc<sup>©</sup>.

McElroy engineers designed the heater to locate on guide rods built into the unit, similar to the entire line of McElroy fusion machines. The compact design also allows for fusing in tight confines.

If you previously owned a Mini-Mc, the inserts you own for the Mini-Mc will work in the 1LC.


